Facts At A Glance

Group "A" Offenses

- ◆ 83,505 total Group "A" offenses reported.
- ◆ 6.6% decrease from 2007 Group "A" offenses.

Crime Rate*

- ◆ 5496.4 per 100,000 inhabitants based on Group "A" offenses.
- ◆ 7.9% decrease from 2007 NIBRS crime rate.
- ◆ 2332.8 per 100,000 inhabitants based on Part 1 offenses (utilized for comparison purposes with non-NIBRS states).

Violent Crime

- ◆ 3,477 violent crime offenses reported.
- ◆ 4.1% decrease from 2007 violent crime offenses.
- ◆ 3.1% decrease of aggravated assault offenses, which accounts for 76.6% of the violent crime.

Crimes Against Persons

- ◆ 19,664 reported crimes against persons.
- ◆ 5.6% decrease from 2007 crimes against persons.
- ◆ 5.1% decrease of simple assault offenses, which accounts for 67.4% of the total crimes against persons.

Officers Assaulted

- ◆ In 2008, no law enforcement officers were killed in the line of duty.
- ◆ 253 total assaults on Idaho law enforcement officers.
- ◆ 0.4% increase from 2007 of reported officers assaulted.

Hate Crime

- ◆ 30 reported hate crime incidents in Idaho for 2008.
- ◆ 21.1% decrease from 2007 hate crimes reported.

Crimes Against Society

- ◆ 13,785 reported crimes against society.
- ◆ 6.6% decrease from 2007 society crime offenses.
- ◆ 6.2% decrease of drug/narcotic violations, which accounted for 48.5% of the total crimes against society.

Property Crime

- ◆ 50,056 reported crimes against property.
- ◆ 7.0% decrease from 2007 total property crime offenses.
- ◆ 5.0% decrease of larceny/theft offenses, which accounted for 47.1% of the total crimes against property.

The crime clock should be viewed with care. Being the most aggregate representation of the UCR data, it is designed to convey the annual reported crime experience by showing the relative frequency of occurrence of the Group "A" offenses. This mode of display should not be taken to imply a regularity in the commission of the offenses, rather, it represents the annual ratio of crime to fixed time intervals.


Group "A" Crime

The term Group "A" offenses is utilized under the National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS) program guidelines to identify reportable offenses committed within a crime incident. An "incident" is defined as one or more offenses committed at the same time and place by the same offender, or group of offenders that are aware of, and consent to, or assist in the commission of the crime (s). Within a single incident, up to ten distinct crime offenses are reportable.



State statutes must be very specific in defining crimes so that persons facing prosecution will know the exact charges being placed against them. For reporting purposes, crime classifications are generically defined to provide a common denominator for which crime data can be uniformly measured by local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies. Therefore, nonconforming offenses outlined under Idaho state statutes should be reported according to the NIBRS definitions.


2008 Group "A" Offenses by Category










