


Crimes Against Society by Day of Week






2015 Drug/Narcotic Violations

Drug/Alcohol Usage in 2015






**Adult Drug/Narcotic Arrests

These offenses are categorized under two types of criminal activity: 1) Prostitution, which is to unlawfully engage in sexual relations for profit. 2) Assisting/promoting prostitution, which is defined as to solicit customers or transport persons for prostitution purposes; to own, manage, or operate a dwelling or other establishment for the purpose of providing a place where prostitution is performed; or to otherwise assist or promote prostitution.





62.9% of the weapons identified in weapon law violations were firearms, of which 12.0% were classified as automatic.


