**Subject:** CCW Reciprocity Letter - Nevada

Dear Ms. Altig:

I represent the State of Nevada, Department of Public Safety. I have been asked to respond to your July 1, 2014 letter inquiring about concealed handgun permit reciprocity between the State of Nevada and the State of Idaho. The State of Nevada does not have a statute that permits the State to enter into reciprocity agreements with other states to recognize concealed firearm permits from other states. Instead, Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 202.3688 authorizes a person who possesses a permit to carry a concealed firearm that was issued by a state included on the list prepared pursuant to NRS 202.3689 to carry a concealed firearm in this State subject to the same legal restrictions and requirements imposed upon a person who has been issued a permit by a sheriff in this State. On a yearly basis, NRS 202.3689 requires the Department of Public Safety, in cooperation with the Nevada Sheriffs' and Chiefs' Association, to examine the requirements for issuance of a permit to carry a concealed firearm in each state and determine whether the requirements of each state are substantially similar to, or more stringent than, the requirements in the State of Nevada, and whether each state has an electronic database which identifies each individual who possesses a valid permit issued by the state that can be accessed at all times through a national law enforcement telecommunications system. The states that meet the requirements of the statute are placed on a list that is provided to law enforcement in the State of Nevada. The list is also made available to the public.

The State of Idaho (Enhanced CCW Permit only) is currently on the list prepared pursuant to NRS 202.3689. I have enclosed copies of the relevant statutes and the current list which appears on the Department of Public Safety's website found at [www.nvrepository.state.nv.us/ccw\\_changes.shtml](http://www.nvrepository.state.nv.us/ccw_changes.shtml).
