Dear Ms. Altig:

Our office has received your letter regarding the State of Idaho entering into a reciprocity agreement with the State of Utah. This letter will serve as a confirmation that according to Utah Code Annotated § 76-10-523(2)(b), the State of Utah honors a permit to carry a concealed firearm issued by other states and counties.

The State of Utah does not require a written reciprocal agreement, but is willing to and will enter into an agreement with the State of Idaho. Also, an Idaho licensee may apply for a concealed firearm permit in our state.
