Does the state of Illinois recognize Idaho's Concealed Weapons License?

However, 430 ILCS 66/40 (e) allows for non-residents to transport a concealed firearm within his or her vehicle in Illinois, if the concealed firearm remains within the vehicle and he or she is not prohibited from owning or possessing a firearm under federal law and is eligible to carry in their state of residence. The Act requires the non-resident to store the firearm within a locked vehicle or locked container within the vehicle if he or she leaves the vehicle.

Does the state of Illinois require a reciprocity agreement?
