Thank you for returning Wyoming's response to Idaho's annual concealed weapons license/permit reciprocity inquiry for 2017.

Wyoming's response indicated that that Wyoming needed an exchange of letters between our states to establish concealed weapons permit license/permit reciprocity. This will serve as Idaho's letter. Under IDAHO CODE § 18-3302(5)(g), the state of Idaho recognizes all other states' concealed weapons licenses/permits as long as the out-of-state person carrying a concealed weapon has his/her valid concealed weapons license/permit in his/her physical possession.
