Population of Boise County: 7,504



Boise County: Numbers of Drug and Alcohol Violation Arrests: 1998 - 2008



Since 1998, alcohol violations (including DUIs, Liquor Violation and Drunkenness) have fluctuated between 18 to 113.


Drug arrests have fluctuated between 3 and 69 over the ten year period, averaging 32 arrests per year.

- Total arrests fluctuated between 86 to 441 between 1998 through 2008, averaging 260 per year.
- Alcohol arrests represented 31.7% of total arrests from 1998 through 2008.
- Drug arrests represented 12.4% of total arrests from 1998 through 2008.

Boise County, Type of Drug Related Arrest by Year: 1998-2008



- Marijuana was seized in more drug related arrests than other drugs. Marijuana was involved in 73.5% of all drug related seizure arrests.
- Meth/amphetamine reached a high of 12 arrests in 2004 and has been involved in an average of 4.4 arrests per year. There were 2 meth related arrests in 2008.
