Population of Madison County: 37,456



Madison County: Numbers of Drug and Alcohol Violation Arrests: 1998 - 2008




- Since 1998, Alcohol Violations arrests (including DUIs, Liquor Violation and Drunkenness) have fluctuated between 160 and 289, averaging 209 per year. There were 160 arrests in 2008.
- Drug arrests have fluctuated between 66 and 144 over the ten year period, averaging 103 arrests per year. There were 132 drug arrests in 2008.

- Total arrests fluctuated between 706 and 949 over the ten year period, averaging 784.6 per year.
- Alcohol arrests represented 26.6% of total arrests from 1998 through 2008.
- Drug arrests represented 13.1% of total arrests from 1998 through 2008.

Madison County, Type of Drug Related Arrest by Year: 1998-2008



- Marijuana was involved in more drug seizure arrests than any other drug. Marijuana was involved in 62.8% of all drug related seizure arrests between 1998 through 2008.
- Meth/amphetamine was involved in between 8 and 27 arrests per year. There were 16 meth arrests in 2008. Meth was involved in 22.2% of drug related seizure arrests between 1998 and 2008.
- Cocaine has fluctuated between 0 and 7 arrests per year. There were 16 arrests involving cocaine in 2008.
